-Sandwich Game

This is a game for two or more players. Each player needs one set of small number cards and a copy of this sheet.

- One player is the dealer. This person shuffles their cards and places them face down on the table.
- The dealer turns over the top card and places it in one of the boxes on their sheet. Other players choose the same card and place it any box.
- The nest card is then turned over and placed by all players. When six cards have been placed, each player finds the difference between their 'Above' number and their 'Below' number.
- The winner is the person who has the smallest difference between the 'Above' number and the 'Below' number.
- The numbers in the 'Above', 'Between', and 'Below' boxes must always be in order at the end of each game.
- O Cards cannot be moved once placed. If a player cannot place a card they lose.
